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In 2017, there were 2,448 inmate tuberculin skin tests administered and read at El Paso County Annex. Of that number, 167 (10.7%) had a measurement of 10 mm or greater.

There were 265 employee tuberculin skin tests administered. Of that number, 2 (0.8%) had a measurement of 10 mm or greater.

There were no suspects and no cases reported in 2017 at El Paso County Annex.
