Order Extending the Temporary Scheduling of FUB-AMB

The Acting Administrator of the Drug Enforcement Administration issued a temporary scheduling order to extend the temporary schedule I status of a synthetic cannabinoid methyl 2-(1-(4-fluorobenzyl)-1*H*-indazole-3-carboxamido)-3-methylbutanoate (other names: FUB-AMB, MMB-FUBINACA, AMB-FUBINACA), including its optical, positional and geometric isomers, salts, and salts of isomers. The schedule I status of FUB-AMB currently is in effect until November 4, 2019. This temporary order will extend the temporary scheduling of FUB-AMB for one year, or until the permanent scheduling action for this substance

is completed, whichever occurs first. This order was published in the *Federal Register*, Volume 84, Number 210, pages 58045-58047, and is effective November 3, 2019.
