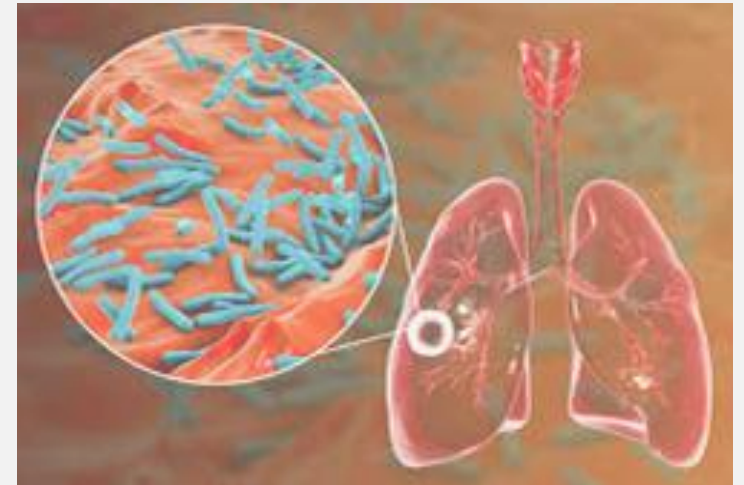

# Part 1: The MDR TB Tab

# Multi Drug Resistant TB (MDR-TB)

- When the TB bacteria becomes resistant to standard drugs used to treat TB disease.
  - MDR TB is resistant to **isoniazid** and **rifampin**
- Can occur when medications used to treat TB are mishandled or mismanaged.



NEDSS data entry in this tab is limited to just those patients diagnosed with MDR-TB.

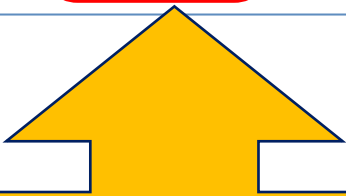
