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## **Preface**

Pursuant to Rider 25(e), 2017-2018 General Appropriations Act, 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017 the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) has reviewed revenue and fees in FY2017. Attached is a copy of the FY 2017 Fee Resource Manual.

This manual compiles basic information about the fee programs administered by DSHS during Fiscal Year 2017. Information contained in this manual includes the date of origin and the statutory authority for each fee. A brief description of the fee, its revenue history, and deposit coding information are also included.

In anticipation of the FY 2018 report, DSHS has delineated between departing and remaining programs following the transformation process required by Senate Bill 200 and Senate Bill 219, 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015.

Finally, the manual is an Appendix A to the Fee Schedule Review – FY 2017 report published by DSHS in accordance with Rider 25(e). The report includes detailed narratives on selected fees under DSHS authority, including a background on specific fee schedules, the purpose of the programs supported by those fees, as well as next steps to further the public health mission of DSHS.

A fee equal to 3% of the analysis fee will be charged for a summary of the quality control data routinely generated during the analysis.

A fee of \$8 per sample will be charged for samples submitted but not analyzed at the submitters' request, including samples on hold, and then voided.

Additional charges: Additional copies of reports and raw data packages will be provided at a cost of \$0.10 per page for each request in excess of 50 pages. An additional fee of \$15 will be charged for each hour in excess of one hour to prepare the request.

Analysis of trip and field blank samples will be billed at the same rate as the requested sample analysis.

Additional charges: If the submitter requires specific samples within their batch to be analyzed and reported as laboratory fortified matrix (FM) or matrix spike (MS), and laboratory fortified matrix duplicate (LFMD) or matrix spike duplicate (MSD), a fee for two additional samples will be charged.

Additional charges: The preparation fee (or 20% of the analysis fee if there is no separate preparation fee) will be charged for any sample prepared but not analyzed at the client's request.

**J-1 Visa**

The department shall collect a fee of \$2,500 to \$5,000 from each applicant who is granted a waiver of the two-year home residency requirement from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services. The Texas Conrad 30 Program has the option to assess the fee each year based on the cost of operating the program. (3) if at the time the application is received by the department, all 30 slots have been used for the fiscal year, 100% of the application fee will be returned to the applicant.

**Vaccine Administration Fee (for Children and Adults)**

As of 1/1/2013 the maximum administration fee that a Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) provider may charge an eligible TVFC patient has increased from \$14.85 to \$22.06 per dose (except for those children who are enrolled in Texas Medicaid or the Texas **Children's Health** Insurance Program (CHIP)). For Texas Medicaid and CHIP eligible patients, the provider should continue to bill the administration fee to the appropriate health plan. If a TVFC provider does not bill CHIP for the administration of a vaccine to a CHIP enrolled child, the provider cannot use TVFC vaccines for this child. If a client is unable to pay for the administration fee of the vaccine, the provider cannot deny the vaccine to the client.



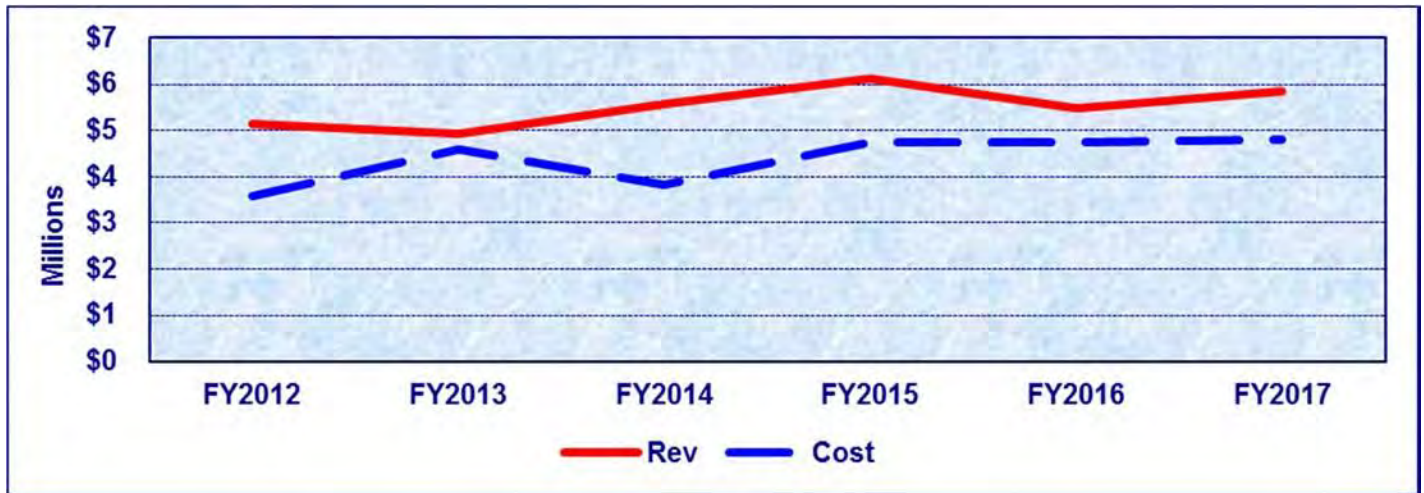

Only uninsured adults are eligible for vaccines under the Adult Safety Net (ASN) program. An ASN enrolled provider may charge an administration fee to the client for each dose that is administered. This charge cannot exceed a maximum of \$25.00 per dose per client. If a client is unable to pay for the administration fee of the vaccine, the provider cannot deny the vaccine to the uninsured client.
