




MRT Growth Trends



In 2014, there were 22,849 active Medical Radiologic Technologists (MRT) providing care in Texas.

- This number represents a 11.1% increase since 2009 and a 11.7% increase since 2004.



- Only 2.8% of the current MRT workforce was eligible for retirement in 2014.
- Within ten years, 17.5% of the current MRT workforce will be at or past retirement age.
- 45.8% of the MRT workforce in 2014 was under 40 years of age.

Geographic Distribution of MRT

Geographic Designation	Ratio of population to MRT
Metropolitan	1,166
Non-metropolitan	1,400
Border	1,757
Non-border	1,146
Texas	1,189

MRTs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 18.2% difference between the number of MRTs in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 42.1%.
