Reassessments will be offered to those individuals annually who are no longer under supervision, at their cost. This procedure will be used to update the risk assessment and will be sent to Texas Department of Criminal Justice. Once Texas Department of Criminal Justice receives the data, the risk classification will be re-evaluated based on rules created by Council on Sex Offender Treatment and reported to the Texas Department of Public Safety (TXDPS.) The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

A motion was made to use the Stable 2000 seconded and passed unanimously.
