1. The meeting was called to order at 0901 by Chair Dudley Wait.
2. The committee reviewed the EMS Education Standards GAP analysis worked on at our workshop on April 7 in Houston. No feedback has been received as of this meeting. We will work with Education to try and get something scheduled before the November meetings.
  - a. Maxie Bishop briefed the Committee on efforts to get prepared for the new national curriculum and National Registry testing. There is an article in the current EMS Magazine and he will work to keep the Committee's up to date on this progress.
3. The committee discussed EMS Education Program accreditation. The appointed task force has finished work on a survey tool and it will be going out to educators, EMS Directors and Medical Directors on Monday, August 22. No other discussion was had.
4. The Committee reviewed the work it had done in two previous meetings on suggestions for Chapter 157 updates and changes. The Committee wanted to discuss several areas with the larger crowd at the main GETAC meetings. These items included:
  - a. Provider Designation Titles
  - b. Vehicle Numbering for daily DSHS use as well as functionality during disasters/large responses
  - c. Two way radio communication capabilities
  - d. Requirements for colormetric devices for all agencies that perform intubation and ETCO2 wave form monitoring for all agencies that perform pharmacologically assisted intubation.

- e. Adding air medical providers back into the Subscription rule
5. Open comment was taken on any other suggestions for changes to Chapter 157. Several comments were received by the Committee.
6. The Committee is trying to meet on September 8 at 1000 in Lubbock and September 15 and 16 in Austin to finalize its work on Chapter 157.
7. The meeting was adjourned at 1035.
