An EMS provider who operates or 6 intends to operate a subscription or membership program for the provision of EMS within 7 the provider service area shall meet all the requirements for an EMS provider license as 8 established by the Health and Safety Code, Chapter 773, and the rules adopted 9 thereunder, and shall obtain department approval prior to soliciting, advertising or 10 collecting subscription or membership fees. In order to obtain department approval for a 11 subscription or membership program, the EMS provider shall: 12 13 (1) Obtain written authorization from the highest elected official (County 14 Judge or Mayor) of the political subdivision(s) where subscriptions will be sold. Written 15 authorization must be obtained from each County Judge if subscriptions are to be sold in 16 multiple Counties. 17 18 (A) The County Judge, as authorized by the Commissioners Court, 19 must provider written authorizations if subscriptions sold across an entire County. 20 21 (B) The Mayor, as authorized by Town or City Council, must 22 provide written authorization if subscriptions are sold exclusively within the 23 boundaries of an incorporated town or city. 24 25 (C) If an EMS Provider seeking approval to sell subscriptions is 26 not the designated EMS Provider for emergency response in any area where 27 subscriptions are to be sold; written notification must be given to the appropriate 28 EMS Provider providing emergency response and to the air medical services 29 that offers service in that response area at least 30 days before seeking 30 approval from the appropriate elected official. EMS Providers that only offer 31 air medical services may omit notification to the local EMS Providers. 32 33 (2) Submit a copy of the contract used to enroll participants. 34 35 (3) The EMS provider shall Maintain a current file of all advertising for 36 the service. Submit a copy of all advertising used to promote the subscription service at 37 least 60 90 days before within ten days after the beginning of any enrollment period. If 38 the EMS Provider offering subscriptions is not the designated EMS Provider for local 39 emergency response, then the advertisement shall **clearly and plainly** identify the local

EMS Provider designated for emergency response. EMS Providers that only offer air

medical services may omit the local EMS Provider name from advertisements. All

advertisements shall promote the use of the national emergency number 9-1-1.

63	(7) Be reviewed at least every two years when the provider license is
64	renewed; and the subscription program may be reviewed by the department during spot
65	inspections; Make subscription records available to the department;

67	(8) Furnish a list after each enrollment period with the names, addresses,
68	dates of enrollment of each subscriber, and subscription fee paid by each subscriber at the
69	close of each enrollment period or semi-annually if the subscription program offers open

72	(9) Furnish the department beginning and ending dates of enrollment
73	period(s) or explain how open year round enrollment will be conducted.

75	(A) Subscribers shall not be charged more than a prorated fee for
76	the remaining subscription service period that they subscribe for.

78	(B) Subscription service period shall not exceed one year.
79	
80	(10) Not offer membership nor accept members into the program who are
81	Medicaid clients.

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(11) Furnish the department with the total amount of funds collected each
year at the close of enrollment or semi-annually if the subscription program offers open
or year round enrollment.

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(b) Failure to comply with the requirements in this section may result in disciplinary actions as listed in §157.16 of this title relating to Emergency Suspension, Suspension, Probation, Revocation or Denial of a Provider License.
