


STAPH

- 12 The presence of bacteria on or in the body without causing infection.
- 13 Carry alcohol hand sanitizer when this is not available.
- 14 A common bacterium carried in the nares of many people.
- 16 An antibiotic that is no longer effective is called this.
- 19 A strain of staphylococcus that has developed antibiotic resistance.
- 20 Wash your hands after touching this part of your body.
- 21 A sign that a sore is infected.
