PPI program Director and Staff have finalized collaboration efforts with College Career Technology Academy (CCTA). Together, this collaboration will help provide PPI services to approximately 100 females (both youth and adult), who are pregnant or postpartum. Program staff has identified a high demand for services on behalf of the population. Case Manager has coordinated services for the students to enroll in Medicaid, WIC, and other necessary resources.

The Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse-Coastal Bend has completed the Distribution and Education application and two of its staff have become Child Passenger Safety Technicians to provide 150 child passenger seats to children in the Coastal Bend in 2016.

The Pregnancy and Postpartum Health Alliance of Texas is a non-profit dedicated to ensuring that all families in the greater Austin area receive the support they need during pregnancy, childbirth, the postpartum period and the transition to parenthood. The website includes resources for mothers, loved ones and professionals. The #1 complication of child birth is depression. About 50% of women who are later diagnosed with Postpartum Depression may have begun experiencing symptoms during pregnancy but only 15% report receiving professional treatment. Also there is a Postpartum Depression Documentary named "Dark Side of the Full Moon" which may be beneficial for staff to view.
