

Medicaid Providers, Have You Re-Enrolled Yet?

Texas Medicaid must comply with federal regulations requiring all providers to re-enroll in the Medicaid program every three to five years. All Medicaid providers enrolled before January 1, 2013 must be fully re-enrolled by March 24, 2016. To be considered fully re-enrolled, providers must submit a completed re-enrollment application and receive notification from the Texas Medicaid & Healthcare Partnership (TMHP) that their application has been approved.

Providers must submit a separate re-enrollment application for each active Texas Medicaid Identifier (TPI) Suffix. This re-enrollment requirement applies to those providers who render services through Medicaid managed care organizations (MCOs), dental maintenance organizations (DMOs), or through traditional fee-for-service Medicaid.

Re-enrollment application processing times will vary based on accuracy and complexity of the application. To allow sufficient time for application processing and to avoid a lapse in enrollment status, [providers are encouraged to begin this process now.](#)

Failure to re-enroll may result in termination from the Medicaid program. Terminated providers will not be eligible to receive payment for services rendered to fee-for-service recipients or those enrolled with a Medicaid managed care organization (MCO) or dental maintenance organization (DMO).
