RAM Licensing Initiatives

- Increased controls licensees should receive information by e-mail
- Some Generally Licensed devices will be elevated
- Disconnected licensing actions should expect to receive a phone call to get things on track

RAM Licensing Initiatives (Cont.)

- We now have a staff member primarily responsible for NSTS
 - NRC notifications of Nationally Tracked Source *non*-receipts
- Industrial Radiographer Trainer cards are almost completely issued

- Safety vs. Security – here to stay
- Read your License – *especially* when you receive an amendment or a renewal
- Ask or Pay

- Some Special Form Certifications expiring soon
- Remember to verify the service company is licensed or has reciprocity
