

On-going Region 8 activities

- Distribute, install, and inspect child car seats and teach parents how to use them correctly
- Recruit and educate *Texas Vaccines for Children* physicians and their office staff
- Participate in the Seguin Wellness Taskforce
- Educate school children about health and wellness
- Teach expectant parents about infant safety
- Educate the community about diabetes through the *Do Well, Be Well Program*
- Serve on the Guadalupe County Child Fatality Review Team
- Vaccinate eligible children and adults

60.3% of children were fully vaccinated at 24 months of age from 2007-2008

The 2007 data reflects the vaccination coverage levels of the 2007-2008 school year kindergarten population when they were 24 months of age. The survey analyzed vaccination records from 14 Guadalupe County public schools. Fully vaccinated means 4 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine, 3 doses of polio vaccine, 1 dose of any measles-containing vaccine, 3 doses of Hib vaccine, 3 doses of hepatitis B vaccine, 1 dose of varicella vaccine and 4 doses of pneumococcal vaccine.
