

On-going Region 8 activities

- Conduct immunization assessments in schools and child care facilities
- Educate children at the Boys and Girls Club on nutrition, hygiene, hand washing, drug and tobacco prevention
- Participate in the Kendall County Child Fatality Review Team
- Educated immunization providers in Kendall, Gillespie and Kerr
- Participate in the Kendall County Child Service Board meetings
- Distribute, install, and inspect child car seats and teach parents how to use them correctly
- Vaccinate eligible children and adults
- Provide health and safety information to Head Start and child care facilities
- Participate in the annual Outdoor Family Health Fair
- Provide STD education, testing and treatment
- Serve on the School Health Advisory Committee

71.2% of children were fully vaccinated at 24 months of age from 2006-2007

The 2006 data reflects the vaccination coverage levels of the 2006-2007 school year kindergarten population when they were 24 months of age. The survey analyzed vaccination records from 6 Kendall County public elementary schools. Fully vaccinated means 4 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine, 3 doses of polio vaccine, 1 dose of any measles-containing vaccine, 3 doses of Hib vaccine, 3 doses of hepatitis B vaccine, 1 dose of varicella vaccine and 4 doses of pneumococcal vaccine.
