


DSHS Organizational Structure Changes

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General Revenue (GR) was re-allocated to program-supporting activities.

Federal Care Grants include any refunds of federal expenditures received. The total to date is \$0.

Changes in FY23 expended are from invoices posted to the ledger since the last reporting data period.

The largest gain in the FY24 budget is due to the increases in the Ryan White award and carryforward funds. Some of these funds are also allocated to ADAP projects and grants. THMP will push unspent Federal Care Grant funds to FY24, totaling \$22,540,363. The first phase is processing \$16,420,897, with the second phase being \$6,119,466. THMP must expend the transferred funds by March 31, 2024.
