## Disclaimer

Most cases of influenza are not reportable in the state of Texas, thus the data in this report was collected from hospitals, clinics, and schools throughout the region who have agreed to voluntarily submit data.

## Definitions


**ILI**: Influenza-Like Illness. This is an illness that resembles the flu, but has not been confirmed. **Rapid**: These tests are typically done in-house to quickly test for influenza. **PCR**: These tests are generally more precise than rapid tests and are performed at the DSHS state lab and many commercial labs to confirm a case of influenza.



# Map of Regional Flu Activity




The map above depicts the previous week's reports of flu or influenza-like illness activity in each county. The legend on the bottom right of the map describes the meaning of each color.

#### **Influenza-Like Illness Projections by Week**



This chart documents the number of rapid tests that have come back positive for flu A and flu B each week throughout the region. **Positive PCR Flu Tests by Week** 




This chart documents the number of PCR tests that have come back positive for flu A and flu B each week throughout the region.
