
Parking is available in parking lots B and C located at the North Entrance of the North Austin Medical Center.

**DIRECTIONS TO TDH QUARTERLY CME CONFERENCE AT THE NORTH AUSTIN MEDICAL CENTER, DECHERD AUDITORIUM**

**1. From the intersection of 183 North and I-35 North:**

Get on highway 183 North and take the MoPac (Loop 1) North exit. Proceed on MoPac North to the FM 1325/Burnet Rd./Duval Rd. exit. Go through the traffic signal (Duval Rd.) and then turn left (north) at the next traffic signal (Burnet Rd./FM 1325 North). Drive north on Burnet Rd. past the traffic signal at Park Bend Dr. to North Austin Medical Center (located on the right). Enter the main entrance parking area. Turn left and go to the area of the North Entrance. Parking is available in Lots B and C.

**2. From the intersection of I-35 North and FM 734/Parmer Lane:**

Traveling north or south on highway I-35, take exit #245 (West FM 734, Parmer Ln.). Proceed west on West FM 734/Parmer Ln. to MoPac (Loop 1) North. Go over the overpass to the traffic signal, turn left, and proceed south to the next traffic signal (Park Bend Dr.). Turn left onto Park Bend Dr., go under the overpass, and take another left at the next traffic signal (Burnet Rd./FM 1325 North). North Austin Medical Center will be on the right. Follow the directions in part 1 to the B and C parking lots.

**3. From Austin - Bergstrom International Airport:**

Exit the airport and turn left on W 71 Texas & 183. Proceed on W 71 Texas and exit North 183. Proceed on North 183, cross over the Colorado River, proceed on North 183 Lampasas. Continue on North 183 (approx. 15 miles) and take the MoPac (Loop 1) North exit. From this location, follow the directions in number 1 above.

**GETTING TO DECHERD AUDITORIUM WITHIN THE NORTH AUSTIN**

**MEDICAL CENTER COMPLEX**

**From the North Entrance (Emergency Entrance):**

Entering the north entrance, take the hallway to the right until you reach the elevators (at the center of hallway on the left). Take the elevator to the second floor, and exit to the left. Proceed down the hallway until you reach Decherd Auditorium on the right side. If you reach the atrium, you are past the entrance to the auditorium.

**From the Main Entrance:**

Entering the main entrance, take the hallway to the left of the Information Desk and go around the corner past the gift shop. Continue down the hallway until you reach the elevators (center of hallway on the right). Take the elevator to the second floor and exit to the left. Proceed down the hallway until you reach Decherd Auditorium on the right side. If you reach the atrium, you are past the entrance to the auditorium.
