


# Selected Cancer Facts - Bell County - 2009






## Leading Three Sites, Childhood and Adolescent Cancer (0-19 years), 1997–2006

Central nervous system neoplasms (ICCC-3 Group III)*	31	24%
Leukemias (ICCC-3 Group I)*	24	19%
Lymphomas (ICCC-3 Group II)*	17	13%
All Other Groups	57	44%

\*ICCC-3 - International Classification of Childhood Cancer. Labels are abbreviated as follows: Group I includes myeloproliferative disease and myelodysplastic diseases; Group II includes reticuloendothelial neoplasms; Group III includes miscellaneous intracranial and intraspinal neoplasms.
