


# Selected Cancer Facts - Comal County - 2009






## Leading Three Sites, Childhood and Adolescent Cancer (0-19 years), 1997–2006

Childhood Cancer Site Group	N	Percent of Total
All childhood and adolescent cancer groups combined	36	100%
Leukemias (ICCC-3 Group I)*	10	28%
Lymphomas (ICCC-3 Group II)*	7	19%
Other epithelial neoplasms and melanomas (ICC-3 Group XI)*	6	17%
All Other Groups	13	36%
