


# Selected Cancer Facts - Hays County - 2009






## Leading Three Sites, Childhood and Adolescent Cancer (0-19 years), 1997–2006

| Childhood Cancer Site Group                                 | N  | Percent of Total |
|---|----|------------------|
| All childhood and adolescent cancer groups combined         | 75 | 100%             |
| Leukemias (ICCC-3 Group I)*                                 | 22 | 29%              |
| Central nervous system neoplasms (ICC-3 Group III)*         | 12 | 16%              |
| Other epithelial neoplasms and melanomas (ICCC-3 Group XI)* | 12 | 16%              |
| All Other Groups  | 29 | 39%              |

\*ICCC-3 - International Classification of Childhood Cancer. Labels are abbreviated as follows: Group I includes myeloproliferative disease and myelodysplastic diseases; Group III includes miscellaneous intracranial and intraspinal neoplasms.
