


Selected Cancer Facts - Tarrant County - 2009







Leukemias (ICCC-3 Group I)*	240	30%
Central nervous system neoplasms (ICCC-3 Group III)*	127	16%
Lymphomas (ICCC-3 Group II)*	105	13%
All Other Groups	319	40%

*ICCC-3 - International Classification of Childhood Cancer. Labels are abbreviated as follows: Group I includes myeloproliferative disease and myelodysplastic diseases; Group II includes reticuloendothelial neoplasms; Group III includes miscellaneous intracranial and intraspinal neoplasms.
