


# Selected Cancer Facts - Wichita County - 2009






## Leading Three Sites, Childhood and Adolescent Cancer (0-19 years), 1997–2006

Childhood Cancer Site Group	N	Percent of Total
All childhood and adolescent cancer groups combined	61	100%
Leukemias (ICCC-3 Group I)*	14	23%
Central nervous system neoplasms (ICCC-3 Group III)*	11	18%
Soft tissue sarcomas (ICCC-3 Group IX)*	7	11%
All Other Groups	29	48%

\*ICCC-3 - International Classification of Childhood Cancer. Labels are abbreviated as follows: Group I includes myeloproliferative disease and myelodysplastic diseases; Group III includes miscellaneous intracranial and intraspinal neoplasms.
