


# Selected Cancer Facts 2009

## Health Service Region 7




In 2009, it is estimated that there will be 11,200 new cancer cases and 4,262 cancer deaths in HSR 7.  
The estimated cost of cancer in HSR 7 for 2007 is \$2.1 billion.\*

### Average Annual Number of New Cancer Cases, Leading 5 Sites, HSR 7, 2002–2006






### Average Annual Number of New Cancer Deaths, Leading 5 Sites, HSR 7, 2002–2006




