


2014 Texas Selected Cancer Facts

Dallas County



These data are used to measure the Texas cancer burden, progress in cancer prevention and control, and support a wide variety of cancer research.




Dallas County

In 2014, it is estimated that there will be 9,638 new cancer cases and 3,681 cancer deaths in Dallas County.
