2010 Summary Report of SHS Ordinance Activity in Texas


Facts	% at end of 2010
TX municipal population covered by smoke-free policies across all five focal settings	45%
TX municipal population covered by smoke-free policies across three or more focal settings	55%
TX municipal population covered by smoke-free municipal worksites	64%
TX population covered by smoke-free private worksites	54%
TX population covered by smoke-free restaurants	59%
TX population covered by smoke-free bars in restaurants	55%
TX population covered by smoke-free bars not in restaurants	46%

# of TX municipal ordinances passed in 2010 6/11 (55%) were SF in all 5 settings; 10/11 (91%) SF in 3 or more settings	11
# of TX municipal ordinances passed in 2009 3/12 (25%) were SF in all 5 settings; 8/12 (67%) SF in 3 or more settings	12

#/% cities with smoke-free municipal worksites	150/266: 56%
#/% cities with smoke-free private worksites	56/266: 21%
#/% cities with smoke-free restaurants	68/266: 26%
#/% cities with smoke-free bars in restaurants	51/266: 19%
#/% cities with smoke-free bars not in restaurants	34/266: 11%


Percentage of the Texas Municipal Population Protected by 100% Smoke-Free Ordinances in Three or More Settings*
