- ▶ A hospital has surrogate parents that will be having their baby delivered later that year. The parents have provided the hospital an order requesting that “None” is placed as the biological mother's name on the birth certificate. How would the hospital handle this situation?

- ▶ Two couples come to the hospital for a surrogacy birth with a gestational agreement. How is the record filed?


