Infectious Substance Category A

An infectious substance in a form capable of causing permanent disability or life threatening or fatal disease in otherwise healthy humans or animals when exposure to it occurs

–Use identification number UN2814 for **Infectious substances, affecting humans**

–Use identification number UN2900 for **Infectious substances, affecting animals**

Infectious Substance Category B

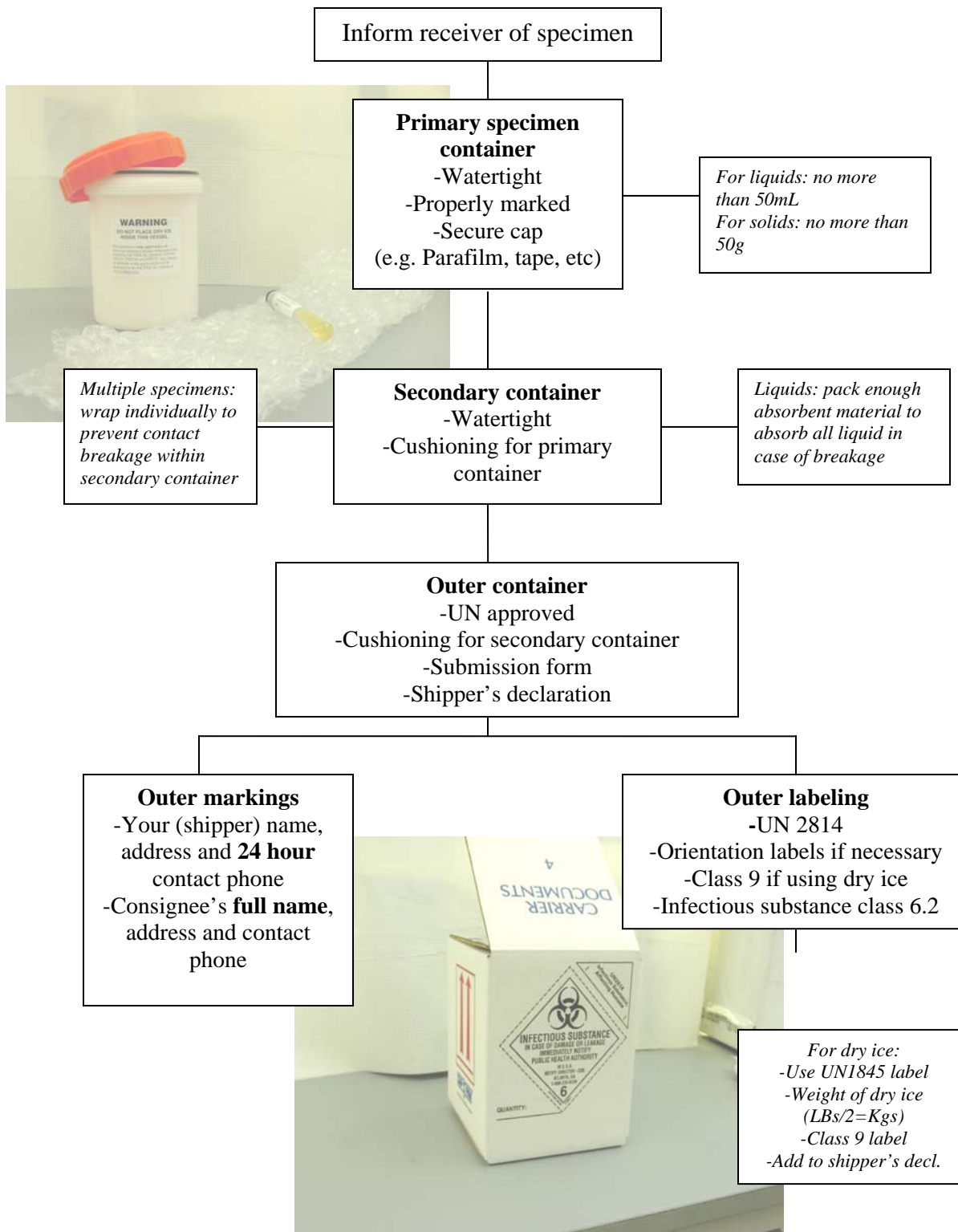
An infectious substance **NOT** in a form generally capable of causing permanent disability or life threatening or fatal disease in otherwise healthy humans or animals when exposure to it occurs

–Use identification number UN3373

Exempt Human or Animal Specimen

DOT does not have this category in their regulations. According to DOT, exempt human or animal specimens are not subject to requirements as Division 6.2 material
