ASBESTOS AND LEAD ABATEMENT EXAMINATION  
COVID-19 SELF-SCREENING**

When you registered for your Asbestos and/or Lead Abatement examinations, information on the website informed you that you would have to complete a COVID-19 Self-Screening before going to the test site. The self-screening is below.

**Please check any of the below symptoms/settings that you are having now/or have experienced in the past 14 days:**

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days (close contact is considered being closer than six feet to someone else for 15 minutes or longer)
- Have traveled outside of the United States in the past 14 days

**If you have:**

- **any of these symptoms; or**
- **had close contact with someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days (close contact is considered being closer than six feet for 15 minutes or longer); or**
- **traveled outside of the United States in the past 14 days:**
  - **you will not be able to take your examination as scheduled;**
  - **you will need to reschedule your examination(s) 14 days after your symptom(s) of COVID-19 have resolved; or**
  - **14 days after your last contact with the person with COVID-19; or**
  - **14 days after you have returned from your travel outside of the U.S.**

You also may want to contact your personal doctor or local health department for more information/advice.

Your examination fee(s) will be applied to the rescheduled test(s).

The examination proctors will be asking if you completed the COVID-19 screening when you arrive onsite for the exam(s).

The examination proctors will let you move forward to sign in for the exams(s) only if you completed the self-screening and did not check off any of the symptoms or settings before arriving onsite for the test(s).
