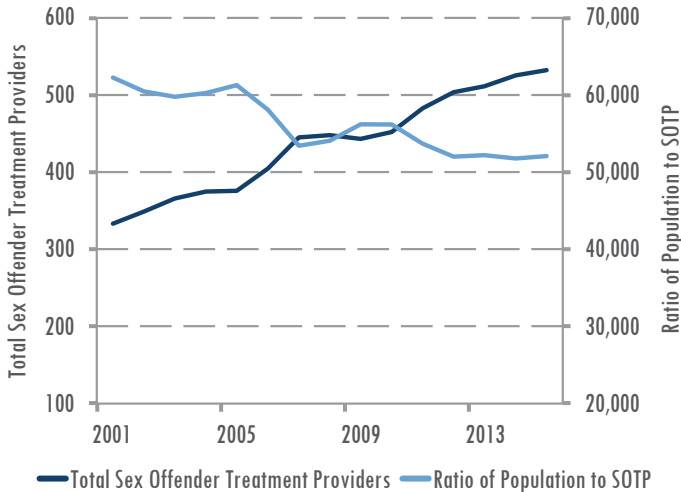




SOTP Growth Trends



In 2015, there were 533 actively licensed sex offender treatment providers (SOTP) providing care in Texas.

- This number represented an 17.9% increase since 2010 and an 42.1% increase since 2005.

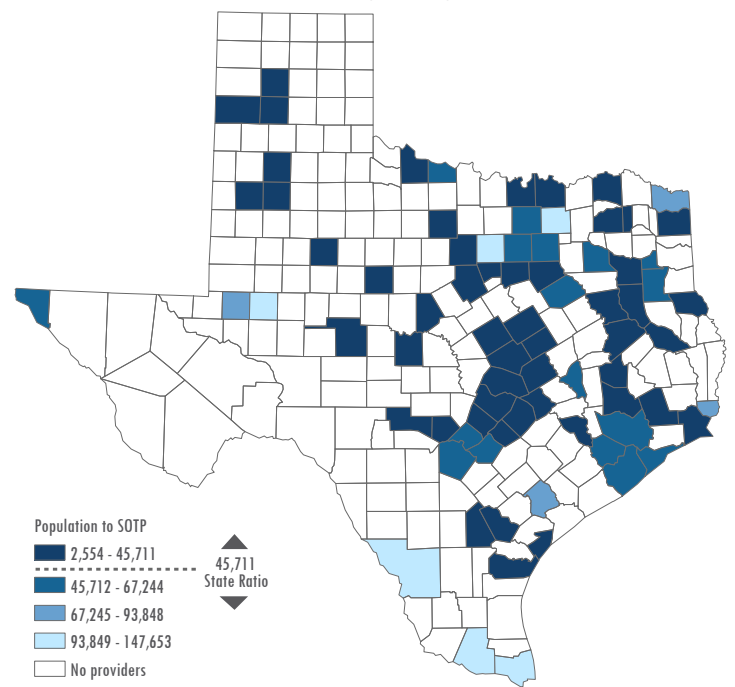
Age Distribution of SOTPs

Within ten years, 47.3% of SOTPs will be at or approaching retirement age.

- 19.7% of SOTPs were eligible for retirement in 2015.
- 36.6% were between 41 and 55 years of age.
- 16.1% of SOTPs were 40 years of age or younger.

Geographic Distribution of SOTPs

SOTPs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 1.9% difference between the number of SOTPs in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 80.9%.
