Within ten years, 53.2% of DTPs will be at or approaching retirement age.

- In 2015, 36.7% were between 41 and 55 years of age.
- 10.1% of DTPs were 40 years of age or younger in 2015.

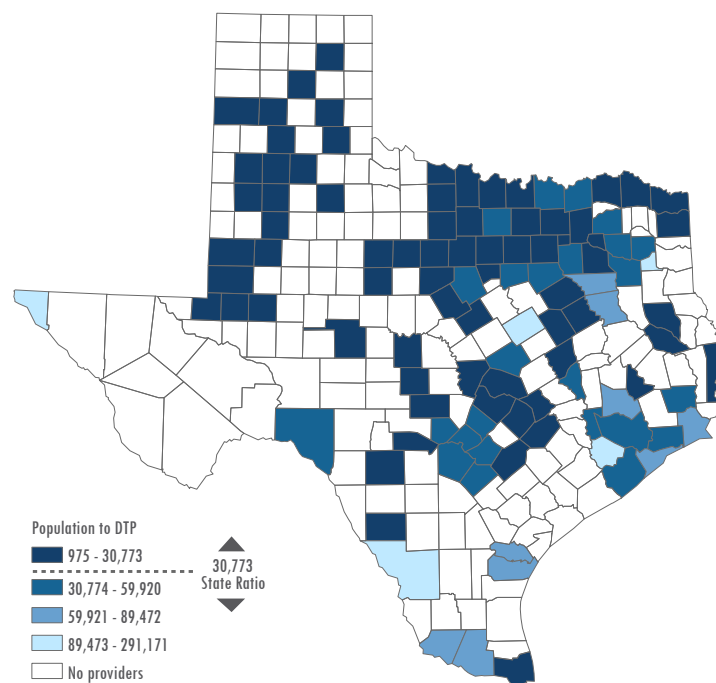
Geographic Distribution of DTPs

Geographic Designation	Ratio of population to DTP
Metropolitan	30,738
Non-metropolitan	31,041
Border	80,091
Non-border	28,718
Texas	30,773

DTPs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 1% difference between the number of DTPs in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 94.4%.

DTP Growth

In 2015, there were 900 actively licensed dyslexia therapists and practitioners (DTP) providing care in Texas.

- This number represented a 8.3% decrease from the previous year.
