

MP Growth Trends



In 2015, there were 434 active Medical Physicians (MP) providing care in Texas.


- This number represents a 5.6% increase since 2010 and a 30.3% increase since 2005.

Age Distribution of MPs

- Only 10.1% of the current MP workforce was eligible for retirement.
- Within ten years, 28.6% of the current MP workforce will be at or past retirement age.
- 45.2% of the MP workforce in 2015 was under 45 years of age.

Geographic Designation	Ratio of population to MP
Metropolitan	57,043
Non-metropolitan	791,542
Border	320,362
Non-border	58,381
Texas	63,814

MPs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 173.1% difference between the number of MPs in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 138.3%.
