




MRT Growth Trends



— Total Medical Radiologic Technologists — Ratio of Population to MRT

In 2015, there were 23,462 active Medical Radiologic Technologists (MRT) providing care in Texas.

- This number represents a 11.2% increase since 2010 and a 11.9% increase since 2005.



- Only 3.1% of the current MRT workforce was eligible for retirement in 2015.
- Within ten years, 18.2% of the current MRT workforce will be at or past retirement age.
- 45.7% of the MRT workforce in 2015 was 40 years of age or younger.

¹ Age data were only available for 23,459 of 23,462 MRTs.

Geographic Distribution of MRTs

Geographic Designation	Ratio of population to MRT
Metropolitan	1,160
Non-metropolitan	1,364
Border	1,739
Non-border	1,138
Texas	1,180

MRTs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 16.2% difference between the number of MRTs in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 41.8%.
