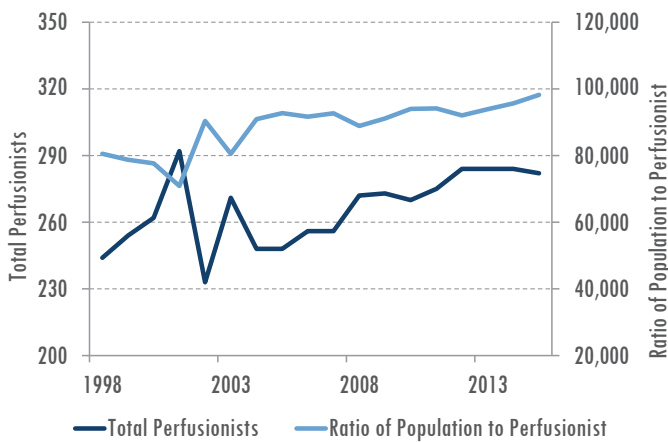

Perfusionist Growth Trends



In 2015, there were 282 active Perfusionists (PER) providing care in Texas.

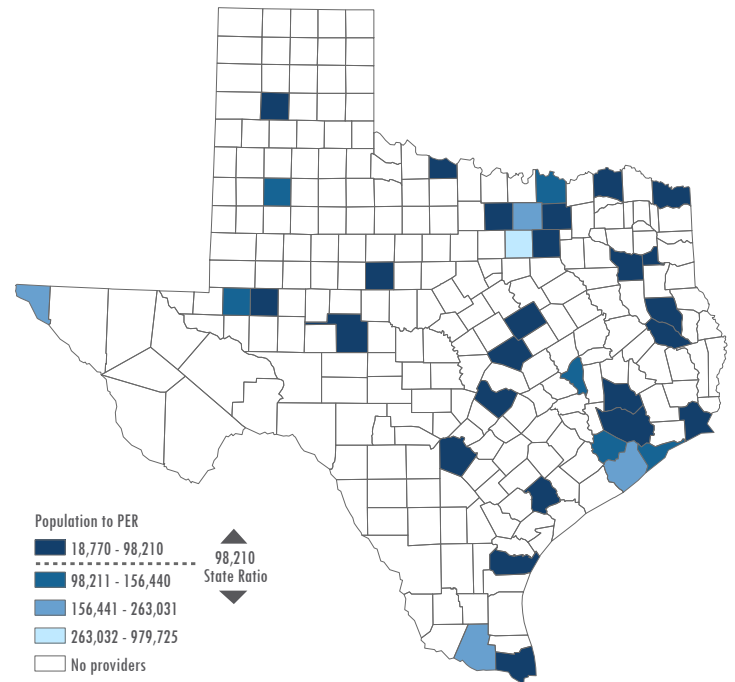
- This number represents a 3.3% increase since 2010 and a 13.7% increase since 2005.

Age Distribution of Perfusionists

- Only 3.9% of the current perfusionist workforce was eligible for retirement in 2015.
- Within ten years, 28% of the current perfusionist workforce will be at or past retirement age.
- 45.8% of the perfusionist workforce in 2015 was under 45 years of age.

Geographic Distribution of Perfusionists

Geographic Designation	Ratio of population to PER
Metropolitan	88,551
Non-metropolitan	633,333
Border	192,217
Non-border	92,929
Texas	98,210

Perfusionists were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- There was a 151.9% difference between the number of perfusionists in metropolitan and non-metropolitan areas even after controlling for population differences.
- Between border and non-border areas the percent difference was 69.6%.
