

Trauma Designation Surveyor Requirements

have direct experience in the preparation for and successful completion of trauma facility verification/designation;	have direct experience in the preparation for and successful completion of trauma facility verification/designation
have successfully completed the department Trauma Facility Site Surveyor Course;	have successfully completed the Department- approved Trauma Facility Site Surveyor Course and be successfully re-credentialed every 4 years

Trauma Nurse Core Curriculum for nurses; or	Trauma Nurse Core Curriculum Course OR Advanced Trauma Course for Nurses AND Pediatric Advanced Life Support OR Emergency Nurse Pediatric Course for nurses
Advanced Trauma Life Support for physicians; and have successfully completed a site survey internship	Advanced Trauma Life Support for physicians; and have successfully completed a site survey internship.
(5) All members of the survey team, except department staff, should come from a public health region and/or RAC outside the hospital's location and at least 100 miles from the applicant hospital. There shall be no business or patient care relationship between the surveyor and/or the surveyor's place of employment and the hospital being surveyed.	(5) All members of the survey team, except Department staff, shall [should] come from a [public health region and/or] TSA [RAC] outside the [hospital's] applicant\health care facility's location and at least 100 miles from the applicant [hospital] applicant\health care facility. There shall be no business or patient care relationship or any potential conflict of interest between the surveyor and/or the surveyor's place of employment and [hospital] applicant\ applicant\health care facility being surveyed.
