Re: Adult Safety Net (ASN) Program – Revision to the Patient Eligibility Screening Form and Reporting Services to Female Veterans

Dear ASN Providers,

In accordance with Senate Bill 805 from the 85th Texas Legislature, Regular Session, the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) must collect and report the number of uninsured female veterans who receive ASN vaccines.

The DSHS Immunization Unit has made changes to the adult eligibility screening form (F11-12842) to collect both the gender and veteran status of each patient. We have also developed an online survey to collect the number of uninsured female veterans who receive ASN vaccines. The eligibility screening form must be presented to all patients at every immunization visit. A hard copy or an electronic copy of the screening form must be in the patient's record and maintained for five years, in accordance with DSHS ASN requirements. The form is currently undergoing translation and a Spanish version will be posted to the website when available.

By the 5th of each month, starting April 5th, 2018, you must use the online survey to document the number of uninsured female veterans who received ASN vaccines in your clinic for the previous month, even if you did not vaccinate any uninsured female veterans. The survey contains only five questions and is available at <http://www.surveygizmo.com/s3/4192963/Reporting-Vaccine-Services-to-UNinsured-Female-Veterans>. The password for the survey is FEMVET.



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DSHS must provide this information to the legislature; therefore, it is important for you to report your information even if you did not vaccinate any uninsured female veterans. You and your staff can select the best way to track this information for monthly reporting.
