Did You Know?

Vaccines normally come in quantities of 1, 5, or 10, with some occasional exceptions like a quantity of 25. Pack sizes are important in the vaccine ordering process. While reviewing provider orders, check every vaccine to ensure that the provider is requesting the appropriate quantity. There are three vaccines that may be ordered in single doses - pediatric DT, Td, and PPSV23. Aside from that, providers may only order vaccines in increments according to the pack size.
