

2013-2014 Annual Report of Immunization Status
Texas Department of State Health Services
Immunization Branch

Texas requires a report of immunization status annually from public schools and accredited private schools (Title 25 Health Services, §§97.61-97.72). The Annual Report of Immunization Status is a self-reported survey that is used to measure immunization coverage among students entering kindergarten and middle school. This data will also assist the Immunization Branch to identify counties with high exemption rates.

The Annual Survey of Immunization Status is mailed to approximately 1,240 independent school districts (ISDs) and 890 accredited private schools in Texas to collect the immunization status of children and the number of conscientious exemption affidavit forms filed at the private school and ISD level. The reports are mailed in September each year, with a snapshot date of the last Friday in October. Data for the number of conscientious and medical exemptions for each vaccine antigen are also collected. Of the schools responding to the 2013-14 annual report, 38,197 students were reported as having a conscientious exemption filed at the school. This number represents 0.75% of the number of students reported enrolled by schools in the annual report survey.

Tables 1 and 2 show aggregated results from the fall of 2013. The percent completely and incompletely vaccinated are shown for each vaccine. Immunization coverage was above 95% for each vaccine. Percent incompletely vaccinated ranged from 0.9 to 3.4 for all vaccine categories. Reported reasons for incompleteness by vaccine antigen are indicated by the type of exemption or status.
