

Immunization records for over nine million adults and children – and counting

ImmTrac holds 140 million immunizations for over nine million adults and children and continues to rapidly grow with increased participation. This important information is gathered from a variety of sources including private health-care providers, public health clinics, Medicaid claims administrators, the Vital Statistics Unit, and third party payors. Regardless of the number of sources, each individual's immunization information is consolidated into one electronic record.

ImmTrac isn't just for kids

ImmTrac stores immunization information for all Texans. By registering to participate in ImmTrac, Texans of all ages are able to have current and historical immunization information stored and consolidated into one central location. Upon registration, authorized health-care providers can access **ImmTrac** client immunization information.

Use ImmTrac effectively

ImmTrac is HL7 compatible with health-care provider's electronic health record (EHR) systems. The Texas Immunization Registry is currently working with providers to complete HL7/Meaningful Use requirements. Reporting immunization information via clinical software eliminates dual entry and saves a provider time and money.
