




# **ImmTrac Snapshot: Q3 2007**

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
- 65.8 million immunizations recorded
- 5.5 million Texas children
- 2 million children under age 6
- >3,900 active online user sites
- >48,000 immunization history reports generated per month (avg)


## Vaccine Doses Recorded (By Quarter)



# Active Online User Sites (By Quarter)







# Immunizations Reported by Electronic Data Import - 2006

# Immunization Histories Generated Online (By Quarter)






# Health Plan Participation

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- 35 health plans reporting
- >4 million immunizations added to ImmTrac client records (2007)
- 23 immunization history request files submitted by 8 health plans
- >27 million immunizations\* conveyed to health plans



# Senate Bill 204

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
- Requires EMR vendors to include capability to interface with ImmTrac or generate electronic reports for data submission
- Requires DSHS to define data exchange fields and standards compatible with national standards



# Senate Bill 204 - Implementation

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
- National standards have not yet been defined
- Projected adoption in 2009
- Rules and implementation will proceed after national standards are adopted
- Working with EMR vendors to facilitate reporting using current standards, new “Electronic Data Translation” technology and HL7 protocol



# Senate Bill 11

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
- Allows for affirmation of consent by a health care provider, birth registrar, regional health information exchange, or local immunization registry
- Allows for inclusion of First Responders or immediate family members
- Requires DSHS to educate First Responders about benefits of ImmTrac



# Senate Bill 11

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
- Provides for reporting of vaccine adverse events through ImmTrac
- Allows for inclusion of information about persons who receive an immunization, antiviral or other medication to prepare for, or in response to, a disaster or emergency event



# Senate Bill 11 – Implementation

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
- Proposed Rules

- Operational planning
- Educational/promotional planning



# Senate Bill 11 – Timeline (Projected)

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
Nov/Dec 2007	Preliminary Stakeholder input on proposed Rules
Jan 2008	State Health Services Council Meeting
Feb/Mar 2008	Public comment period
Jun/Aug 2008	Rules effective date Rollout of new functionality
