

# 2013 Hospital Summary Report

## *RAC R*

The Hospital Summary Report provides a brief overview of the trauma hospitalization data submitted by each RAC to the Texas EMS/Hospital Trauma Registry. The data is trauma patients that meet the following criteria: patient was admitted for greater than 48 hours OR patient was seen, received stabilization care, and then transferred to a higher level acute care hospital OR patient died after receiving any evaluation or treatment or was dead on arrival. All hospitals in Texas are required to report per the TAC Rule §103.11.

This report includes only trauma hospitalization records successfully submitted to the Texas EMS/Trauma Registry for the year specified.


