

Revision to medical RSO and user application forms

The medical rules in 25 TAC 289.256 were updated in January 2022 to be consistent with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regulations.

With the medical rule changes, the application forms to document and certify an individual's training qualifications needed to be updated. We have chosen to adopt the pdf fillable NRC application forms since these forms are typically used nationally. This will provide a consistent application form to document the individual's training and qualifications.

Use NRC form	To document user training and experience for
313A(RSO)	Radiation Safety Officer (and Associate Radiation Safety Officer)
313A(AUD)	Authorized Users for (1) Uptake, dilution, and excretion studies, (2) Imaging and localization studies, or (3) Sealed sources for diagnosis
313A(AUT)	Use of unsealed radioactive material for which a written directive is required (including I-131)
313A(AMP)	Authorized Medical Physicist or Ophthalmic Physicist
313A(ANP)	Authorized Nuclear Pharmacist
313A(AUS)	Manual brachytherapy, Ophthalmic use of strontium-90, Remote afterloaders, teletherapy units, or Gamma stereotactic radiosurgery units
