

## **RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES PILOT PROJECT**

May 2014 - Present

A Request for Proposal to fund a Recovery Support Services (RSS) pilot project was sent out in November 2013. Based on funding and number of applicants twenty-two organizations were funded to participate in the RSS pilot project. The twenty-two organizations were comprised of 14 Substance Use Treatment (TO), 6 Community-Based (CO) and 2 Peer-Run Recovery (RCO) organizations. The goal of the pilot project was to: 1) increase focus on peer-support services 2) increase focus on aligning treatment services with a recovery-oriented approach, and 3) increase focus on expanding community supports available to assist individuals to successfully integrate into their communities. Services provided under the Recovery Support Services pilot project allowed for a wide array of non-clinical services and supports to help individuals initiate, support and maintain recovery from alcohol and other drug use. As of today (2/2016) the project is still being evaluated by the University of Texas Center for Social Work Research Addiction Research Institute.

Below is a list of some recovery support services that have been provided between May 2014 and June 2015.

- Over 10,000 participants received recovery support services.
- Over 35,000 hours of recovery support were provided.
- 119 Recovering Persons were recruited into the program to serve as Recovery Coaches
- Recovery Coaches engaged 1,130 individuals in long-term (minimum 12 months) one-on-one recovery coaching.
- Over 1,400 other volunteers joined the program providing over 13,000 hours of volunteer services with estimated value of \$182,900 (Interim Evaluation Report , Mangrum, Spence, Nichols & Petersen 8/2015)

Below is a list of some not all preliminary outcomes for those participants receiving long-term recovery coaching from May 2014 – June 2015.

- Increase in number of participants housed and living in residences that they either personally own or rent
- Increase in number of participants having a full-time and/or part-time employment
- Increase in employment wages
- Increase rates of abstinence and/or reduced use
- Increase in personal recovery capital
- Decrease in healthcare service utilization
- \*\*\*These participant outcomes results so far suggest that retention in long-term recovery coaching may be associated with improved health and wellness in multifaceted domains of life functioning (Interim Evaluation Report , Mangrum, Spence, Nichols & Petersen 8/2015).
