ADV-59

This advisory is issued as a result of sampling of Mountain Creek Lake. Fish samples collected from Mountain Creek Lake indicate the presence of dioxins and PCBs at concentrations exceeding health assessment guidelines established by the Texas Department of State Health Services. Consumption of fish from Mountain Creek Lake may pose a threat to human health.


