

AQUATIC LIFE ORDER NUMBER 16

Pursuant to Chapter 436 of the Texas Health and Safety Code, it is hereby ORDERED that: Samples of fish collected from Fosdic Lake, Tarrant County —covered by Aquatic Life Order AL-10 issued by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) (formerly the Texas Department of Health) on April 5, 1995— indicate that the levels of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) have decreased to a level that does not warrant a closure action. Subsequently, a fish consumption advisory (ADV-33) will be issued recommending limited consumption of fish from Fosdic Lake. Therefore, the Aquatic Life Order AL-10 issued for Fosdic Lake is hereby rescinded. This order is effective at 12:01 a.m., December 20, 2007, and remains in full force and effect until modified or rescinded by further written order.
