Severe Headache That Won't Go Away or Gets Worse Over Time



Vaginal Bleeding or Fluid Leaking During Pregnancy



Severe Nausea and Throwing Up (Not Like Morning Sickness)



Thoughts About Harming Yourself or Your Baby



Changes in Your Vision



Overwhelming Tiredness



Baby's Movement Stopping or Slowing During Pregnancy



Chest Pain or Fast-beating Heart



Extreme Swelling of Your Hands or Face



Dizziness or Fainting



Swelling, Redness or Pain of Your Leg



Severe Belly Pain That Doesn't Go Away



Trouble Breathing



Fever of 100.4 °F (38°C) or Higher



Heavy Vaginal Bleeding or Leaking Fluid That Smells Bad After Pregnancy
