

Example of an Entry Level Job at Texas Health Steps

- Program Specialist II
 - Recruit and retain medical/dental providers by providing technical assistance
 - Develop and conduct training programs on policies and procedures as requested by providers
 - Act as a liaison between providers and state programs
 - Educate and promote the Texas Health Steps program within the community
 - Identify gaps in program resources, and develop Corrective Actions Plans if requested
 - Prepare reports and studies on provider relations
- Required education: Bachelor's Degree in Public Health or a related field
- Preferred skills: Effective written communication and presentation skills, connects
 effectively and professionally with others, adapts well through on-the-job training,
 knowledge of resources and programs that serve children
