

TEXAS MORBIDITY for 1947

THIS ANNUAL SUMMARY SHOWS THE REPORTED INCIDENCE OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES IN TEXAS BY COUNTY FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR OF 1947. FOR COMPARISON THE TOTAL OCCURRENCE DURING 1946 IS ALSO INDICATED. THE DISEASES WHICH SHOW A SIGNIFICANT INCREASE IN 1947 WERE INFLUENZA, WHOOPING COUGH, MUMPS AND CHICKENPOX. POLIOMYELITIS DECREASED MARKEDLY,

THERE BEING ONLY 183 CASES REPORTED COMPARED WITH 979 DURING 1946. OTHER DISEASES WHICH DECREASED IN 1947 WERE UNDULANT FEVER AND MEASLES.
