SOURCES OF DATA

This document carries final figures on the reported incidence of notifiable diseases in 1977. Data are submitted to the Surveillance and Information Program, Bureau of Communicable Disease Services, through the statewide morbidity reporting system and are supplemented by data collection and surveillance activities of the Epidemiology Division, the Bureau of Tuberculosis Services, the Infectious Diseases Control Division, and the Bureau of Vital Statistics. The population figures from 1970-1977 used in computing rates are from the Current Population Reports, Series P-25, published by the federal Bureau of the Census.

The morbidity data in this report represent cases reported to the Texas Department of Health through city and county health departments, local health officers, and other reporting agents. The degree of completeness is influenced by the interests and priorities of these various reporting sources for disease control and surveillance; however the degree of underreporting is thought to remain consistent over time allowing data comparison over the years.






ANTHRAX - Reported Cases Per 100,000

INCIDENCE RATE PER 100,000 POPULATION




A S E P T I C M E N I N G I T I S - Reported Cases Per 100,000

INCIDENCE RATE PER 100,000 POPULATION




B R U C E L L O S I S - Reported Cases Per 100,000



By Year, Texas




PSITTACOSIS

Reported Cases Per 100,000 Population by Year, Texas




ENCEPHALITIS - Reported Cases Per 100,000



INCIDENCE RATE PER 100,000 POPULATION




ENDEMIC TYPHUS - Reported Cases Per 100,000 Population







MALARIA - Reported Cases Per 100,000 Population by Year, Texas






MALARIA ACQUIRED OUTSIDE OF THE UNITED STATES





By Year, TEXAS





POLIOMYELITIS - (PARALYTIC)





Population By Year, Texas






ROCKY MOUNTAIN SPOTTED FEVER




RUBELLA - Reported Cases Per 100,000 Population,








SHIGELLA - Reported Cases Per 100,000 Population,






TETANUS - Reported Cases Per 100,000 Population,
By Year, Texas






TULAREMIA - Reported Cases Per 100,000 Population,
