Figure 1. Texas Counties Reporting any Arbovirus Activity, Weeks 1-26




Figure 2. Epidemiologic Curve of Mosquito WNV Activity, 2013-2015





Figure 3. Epidemiologic Curve of Human WNV Activity, 2013-2015
