Figure 1. Texas Counties Reporting any Arbovirus Activity, Weeks 1-20




Figure 2. Epidemiologic Curve of Mosquito WNV Activity, 2015-2017




Figure 3. Epidemiologic Curve of Human WNV Activity, 2015-2017
